DOT Animation Project:

Accelerating Deaf Owned Translation of the Bible

I'm Eric Raingruber and I'm an animator working with Wycliffe Associates in Deaf Owned Translation of the Bible.

The Urgency

Over 400 deaf languages lack a translation of the Bible, leaving 75 million individuals without access to the life-changing message of the Scriptures. Often, the Deaf are the forgotten, the "least" in their cultures, with extremly limited literacy rates¹. For the Deaf that can read and have the written Word, it's not in their heart language, as spoken language differs significantly from sign language.

Wycliffe Associates' Unwavering Commitment

For over five decades, Wycliffe Associates has dedicated itself to streamlining and expediting Bible translation to reach hundreds of millions who remain without access to the Scriptures. The global Deaf community stands as one of the largest remaining unreached and unengaged people groups. Wycliffe is actively working towards translating and filming the Bible



in every sign language, with 30 Deaf-owned translations in progress and 5 New Testaments partially completed.

The Power of Animation

Animation serves as a catalyst in the translation process for passages with no direct translation. Like footnotes in a written Bible, our team creates visually compelling animations to explain foreign concepts. The uniqueness of animations lies in their universality – applicable to all 400 Deaf translations, and serving as visual footnotes for completed translations.

Progress and Aim

Having completed animations for two Old Testament books, the DOT Animation Project aims to finish animations for ten books of the Bible in 2024. To achieve this, we need to increase monthly support, allowing us to expand the work for our current team and bring on an additional parttime animator.

The ultimate vision is to create DOT Animations to aide in translation for every book of the Bible, leaving no Deaf community without access to the Scriptures.
